Dear Dean:

Thank you for your continued attention to the faculty union contract implementation process. I am writing in regard to the multi-year contract addendum agreement that was recently executed under the Non-Tenure System Faculty Agreement between the University and UIC United Faculty Local 6456, IFT-AFT, AAUP. This addendum agreement requires the following action by the college.

In accordance with this addendum agreement, paragraph 1:

For appointments made for the 2014-2015 academic year only, all non-visiting NTT faculty who are reappointed to their positions that are not funding contingent and have completed at least ten (10) consecutive years of service in their current (not funding contingent) positions prior to August 16, 2014, will be offered a multi-year appointment.


Attached you will find a list of individuals that have been identified to be in the NTT bargaining unit that meet the 10 consecutive year requirement. In case it is helpful, I have highlighted questionable faculty you identified during my initial inquiry in April in yellow. The college should review this listing for accuracy, in light of recent departures/changes, and to determine eligibility based on funding contingencies. For the purposes of this addendum agreement, "funding contingent" is as defined based on the University's definition of "subject to receipt of funds" and is identified by the presence of the asterisk (*) on the Notification of Appointment.

We have drafted a recommended letter template for you to issue along with the multi-year contract document to be executed (2 original copies) and submitted to our office. We ask for return of the fully executed multi-year contracts no later than Monday, July 14, 2014. If for any reason, a faculty member declines the offer of the multi-year appointment or you have issued a notice that the faculty member will not be reappointed for 2014-2015, please notify our office accordingly.
